ORDINANCE NO. 2023-

VILLAGE OF BROWNSVILLE, DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

An Ordinance to Repeal Section 12.20 of the Brownsville Municipal Code

WHEREAS, the village board of the Village of Brownsville desires to repeal its ordinance which prohibits rural delivery mailboxes.

WHEREAS, section 12.20 of the Brownsville Municipal Code presently reads as follows:

12.20 RURAL DELIVERY BOXES PROHIBITED. (Recr. fr. § 12.20, 010) It is unlawful for any person to erect or cause to be erected a rural delivery mail box within the corporate boundaries of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Brownsville do ordain as follows:

- I. Section 12.20 (Rural Delivery Boxes Prohibited) of the Brownsville Municipal Code is hereby repealed.
- II. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication according to law.
