VILLAGE OF BROWNSVILLE, DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

**An Ordinance to Repeal Section 12.20 of the Brownsville Municipal Code**

---

WHEREAS, the village board of the Village of Brownsville desires to repeal its ordinance which prohibits rural delivery mailboxes.

WHEREAS, section 12.20 of the Brownsville Municipal Code presently reads as follows:

12.20 RURAL DELIVERY BOXES PROHIBITED. (Recr. fr. § 12.20. 010) It is unlawful for any person to erect or cause to be erected a rural delivery mail box within the corporate boundaries of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Brownsville do ordain as follows:

**I. Section 12.20 (Rural Delivery Boxes Prohibited) of the Brownsville Municipal Code is hereby repealed.**

**II. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication according to law.**
