Marshal Stuckart's report included:

Supt. Lechner's Report Included:

- Water tower painters have arrived, and work has begun. The park will remain closed until completion.
- A massive water main broke on Main Street. Worst DPW has ever seen. Clean up is completed, and system is back up and running.

- A chlorine pump had failed and the back up was broken. A new one was purchased and installed.
- CMAR was received by the DNR.
- DNR partially approved land for sludge to be dumped on.
- Crack filling around the Village will begin soon.

Discussion on SAFEbuilt permit fees in the future. Clerk Hull had a meeting with SAFEbuilt to go over current rates established from 2014 and where current rates are now.
